#### CONTRACT MANAGEMENT

Contract is another name for business relationship. Understandably, companies and government and other organisations enter into a large number of contractual relationships with numerous companies and suppliers. A company gets into a contractual relationship with the State to get a project, licence or business. Companies and government undertakings enter into contractual relationships with raw material and component suppliers, finished goods suppliers, works contractors and service providers. Companies get into relationships with distributors, wholesalers, and retailers for selling their products and services.

Indian Economy is the fastest growing economy in the world and India is on path to become the third longest economy in a few years. This growth in economy is bringing about salient changes in the contracting landscape. Geopolitical situation is also impacting the various facets of supply chain and particularly the contracting and the new era of nearshoring, friendshoring, technology transfer and to some extent protectionism is taking shape and creation of platform like GeM is bringing new challenges in contracting and contract management. Use of technology in SCM is becoming popular and smart contracts will be the future. Opening up of large segments of economy for private participation particularly in infrastructure, Railways, Highways, Waterways, Cold supply chain, Telecommunications, Airports, E-commerce etc are forcing govt. and companies to look for new approach to contracting and proliferation of new contractual relationships. A large number of contracts are being concluded in PPP model. The legal, transparency, accountability and compliance aspects are becoming move prominent issues in contracting. As a result, managing contracts for goods, works, services, technology transfer, contracting in PPP mode have become a dominant activity for managers in private, govt. and PSU sectors needing upgradation of knowledge in contract management.

The changes in legal scenario particularly with respect to dispute resolution are also having a great impact on contracting and management of contracts.

Contract failures lead to inefficient performance, financial losses, and disruption of work; initiation of mediation, arbitration and litigation; loss of reputation; and other direct and consequential losses. Thus, it has become important for executives to understand the rights, responsibilities, and obligations arising from contracts and the related intricacies.
